



The Patriarch of Antioch speaking to all at the Procession going to the Vatican (Seeking the Publication of the Missing Text of the Third Secret)

Standing in St. Peter's Square, His Beatitude, Gregorios III Laham, the Patriarch of the Melkite Uniate Catholic Church of Damascus and Antioch, gave this short public address to Father Nicholas Gruner and Father Lino Popian and to all those in the procession.



“I come from the city which saw the conversion of St. Paul, where he began. With St. Paul, the Gospel has been truly written in a journalistic manner (*mediatico*). In such a manner, St. Paul was able to carry it into the desert of Syria where he was praying and reflecting on the Gospel for three years.

“St. Paul learned, not from books, not from Father Lino or from Father Gruner, but from the Holy Spirit. Then he went out into the world to carry the good news to all of us. Congratulations to you (Father Gruner and Father Popian) and may God bless you and keep you. It is our piety that aids us to remain Christian and believing. Our piety enables us to carry the Word of God to others, telling the world that God loves us, that God loves all of us, whoever we are.

“This is the nucleus, this is the core of our Gospel of the whole Christian Faith. Love, love, love.

“Thank you. Again, many congratulations and may the Virgin Mary – Whose real home is not Rome, nor Fatima; but Her house is in the Holy Land at Nazareth, at Lebanon, where She lived – may She also live among you in every house and family. “
